Current President of the Student Senate for California Community Colleges, Reid E. Milburn is a student of Sacramento City College and former SSCCC Executive Secretary, Region V Senator, as well as Columbia College AS President. President Milburn has a long history of student and military leadership. A passionate advocate for education, she gained a love of learning from her mother, an elementary school teacher and a desire to serve those unable to represent themselves from her father, a Viet Nam veteran.

Ms. Milburn grew up in the Los Angeles and San Luis Obispo areas. In March 1997, she enlisted in the United States Air Force and was assigned to the Presidio of Monterey as a Korean Linguist in April of that same year. She transferred to Keesler Air Force Base in 1998 to train as an Air Traffic Control Radar Systems technician. While at Keesler, she was awarded the Air Force Achievement Medal for her actions as a Student Leader in charge of a squadron of over 500 students during the landfall of Hurricane Georges. In 1999, she was stationed at Sheppard AFB working with the Euro-NATO Joint Jet Pilot Training Program's various Air Traffic Control and weather radar systems. Sergeant Milburn served briefly with the Royal Air Force at Incirlic Air Base, Turkey as part of Operation Northern Watch in 2000. Upon returning to Sheppard AFB, she was handpicked to serve as the Base Commander's, Non-Commissioned Officer in Charge, Wing Protocol Office, where she acted as a liaison between the base and the local community and presided over all official ceremonies and dignitary visits for Sheppard AFB.

Sergeant Milburn's military decorations include the Air Force Commendation Medal, Air Force Achievement Medal, Outstanding Unit Award, Good Conduct Medal, National Defense Service Medal, Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal, Global War on Terrorism Service Medal, and the Small Arms Marksmanship Ribbon. After serving two tours of duty, Staff Sergeant Milburn was honorably discharged in April 2005.

President Milburn is currently pursuing an associate degree through the California Community College system with an emphasis in History and Communication and intends to transfer to UC Davis to complete her Baccalaureate in either History or Political Science. From there she plans to complete her Juris Doctorate and practice law in California and plans to continue to fight to preserve accessible and affordable education long after her term with the Student Senate Council ends. In her spare time, if she can find any, Ms. Milburn also enjoys reading, driving, politics, and horseback riding. She currently resides in Sacramento, California.
