As always, our team is excited to visit every one of your colleges. If you have any major spring events we can table at, please email me, and I'll make sure Region IV is there.

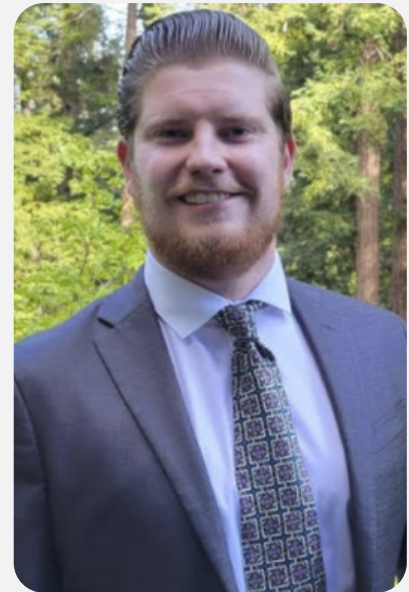
